- **Early pick-up of parade number:** Your number for parade placement will be available prior to line-up at the Chamber of Commerce from 9 am - 4 pm Friday. You must pick up your number. You may not call to find out placement.

- Absolutely NO candy, gum or goodies can be thrown to the crowd from your float; it must be handed out by someone on foot!
- Please pause as you pass the judges table at the Heritage Park Pavilion to give the judges a better look at your entry.
- Parade will follow the traditional parade route: Starting at 6<sup>th</sup> & Main St., proceeding north along Main St. to Wall St., west to National Ave., south to 6<sup>th</sup> St.
